8800 movement power storage time



Overview

Let's cut to the chase: The Omega 8800 movement stores energy for approximately 55 hours on a full wind [1] [6] [9]. But wait – this isn't just another dry spec sheet. Imagine being able to take off your watch Friday evening and still find it ticking Monday morning. How much power does a caliber 8800 have?

It has a power reserve of 55 hours and is resistant to magnetic fields reaching 15,000 gauss. It has a free sprung-balance with silicon balance spring, The caliber 8800 has a rhodium-plated finish with Geneva waves in arabesque. Both calibers beat at 25,200 vph and have 35 jewels.

What is the difference between a Cal 8900 and a 8800?

The twin barrel (aka double barrel) design allows for an extended power reserve of up to 60 hours, compared to 55 hours for the 8800. Furthermore, the 8800 has 35 jewels vs the cal. 8900 with 39 jewels.

What are the specifications of Omega caliber 8800 & 8801?

So let's look closer at the specifications of the Omega caliber 8800 and 8801. The caliber 8800 is a self-winding movement with a co-axial escapement. The rotor is winding in both directions. Each movement is tested according to the Master Chronometer certification process approved by METAS.

Does the 8800 keep a good time?

So far the 8800 is keeping great time. My SMP loses between 1 and 1,5 second per day. Now this brings us at a very strange thing. according to my METAS test results, my clock averaged + 2,8 seconds per day during the METAS test. The +2,8 seconds per day, is the average rate of the 6 positions they measure (equally weighted).

How much does the Omega caliber 8800 cost?

The Omega caliber 8800 is an in-house movement and not available for

individual purchase, even for Swatch Group parts accounts. At the time of this post, the retail prices of the watches this movement powers ranges from \$8,300 USD to \$14,000 USD.

What caliber is 8800?

The caliber 8800 has a rhodium-plated finish with Geneva waves in arabesque. Both calibers beat at 25,200 vph and have 35 jewels. The beating of 25'200 vibrations per hour is rather unusual, but omega determined this to be optimal. T he caliber is 26mm / 11.5'''.

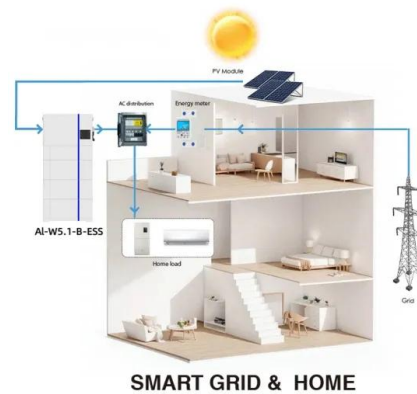

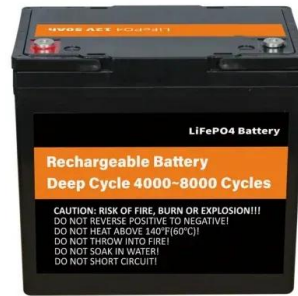
