Can gas be stored in a canister?

Gasoline should only ever be stored in containers that have been approved for that purpose by the Department of Transportation. Look for the DOT name or logo on canisters before you buy them to ensure they are safe. Many gas containers are made of sturdy plastic and come in a variety of colors depending on the liquid they're designed to hold.
